

The Basset Hound Club Breed Appreciation Day with Multiple-Choice Breed Standard Exam Speaker: Mrs Debbie Ellrich

The Breed Appreciation Day (BAD) will be run in accordance with the RKC Judges Education Programme (JEP). The BAD will give anyone who wishes to judge the Basset Hound, and progress through the JEP levels, a thorough understanding of the Breed Standard. There will be a multiple-choice examination (MCE) for those eligible.

Eligibility

The BAD is open to all who wish to gain a better understanding of the Basset Hound.

The BAD and MCE are a mandatory requirement for all judges wishing to progress from Level 1 to Level 2 on the JEP. The RKC has stated that all judges will need to meet all the requirements of JEP Level 1 in order to undertake any judging appointment.

The MCE can only be undertaken by those candidates who are passed to award CC's in at least one breed, OR meet the JEP Level 1 requirements, which are:

- Have a minimum of five years proven interest in pedigree dogs.
- Have attended and passed the KC Requirements of a Dog Show Judge seminar.
- Passed the Points of a Dog assessment.
- Have attend the KC Conformation and Movement Seminar, and
- Completed a minimum of two full-day stewarding appointments.

It is the responsibility of the candidate that they meet these requirements and have evidence to upload to KC IT system once it is active.

Application for a place – Spaces will be strictly limited and allocated on a first come, first serve basis The BAD will have a maximum of 30 candidates and the MCE a maximum of 20 candidates.
